



BLUEBIRD UPDATE

Further to Meteoric Resources' previous announcement of drill intersections at the Bluebird copper-gold prospect near Tennant Creek (MEI ASX Release 14 November 2012), results of follow-up sampling of 1m intervals have been received. 1m samples from the mineralised ironstone in drill hole BBRC-2 have returned a grade of **4m @ 4.7% Cu and 0.38g/t Au from 115m (0.5% Cu cut-off) including 1m @ 16.2% Cu and 1.19g/t Au from 116m**, see Figure 1.

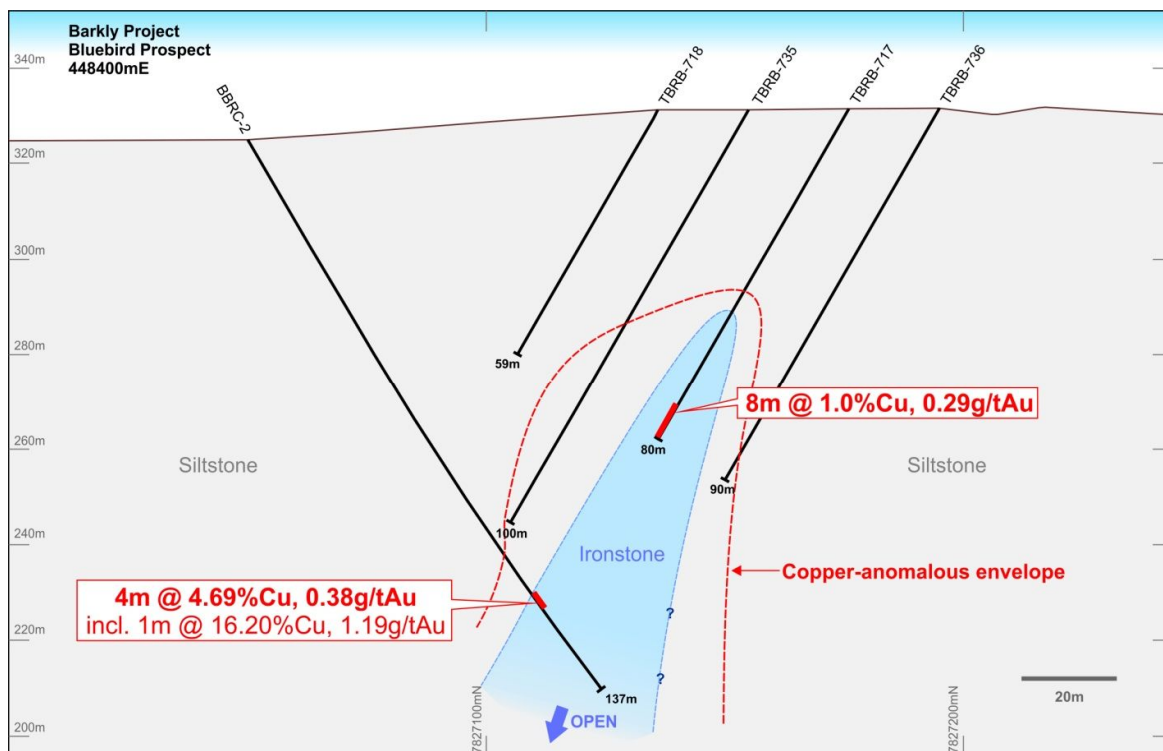

The check analyses confirm the previously announced high grade intersection based on 4m composite samples (8m @ 2.2% Cu, 0.26g/t Au from 112m, including 4m @ 3.7% Cu, 0.30g/t Au from 116m). Meteoric is encouraged by the confirmation of high-grade Tennant Creek style copper-gold mineralisation associated with a 1.6km-long gravity ridge interpreted to reflect widespread hematite ironstone alteration. The mineralisation remains open at depth.
